When the construction of the school, which was initiated in the district of Çiftlikköy based on a protocol executed by and between the Governorate of Yalova, Provincial Directorate of National Education and Aksa Akrilik, is completed, it will meet the vocational training needs in Yalova and thereby, make a significant contribution to the development of the province. Recognizing the importance of education for the future of Yalova, Aksa Akrilik remains dedicated to making further investments in education. The new technical high school will endeavor to raise qualified work force by ensuring that student will acquire practical skills in addition to theoretical knowledge.

Designed as a modern school that will meet all vocational training needs of students, it will be commensurate with the cutting-edge innovations. Constructed on a land of 5,370 sqm, the high school will perform various functions in its education building with 12 classrooms, 8 workshops, 3 laboratories and 1 library constructed on a building site of 5,859 sqm, and an indoor gym of 942 sqm.

The high school which will be handed over to the Ministry of National Education upon the completion of construction process will endow student with the knowledge and skills required in our contemporary world.
